



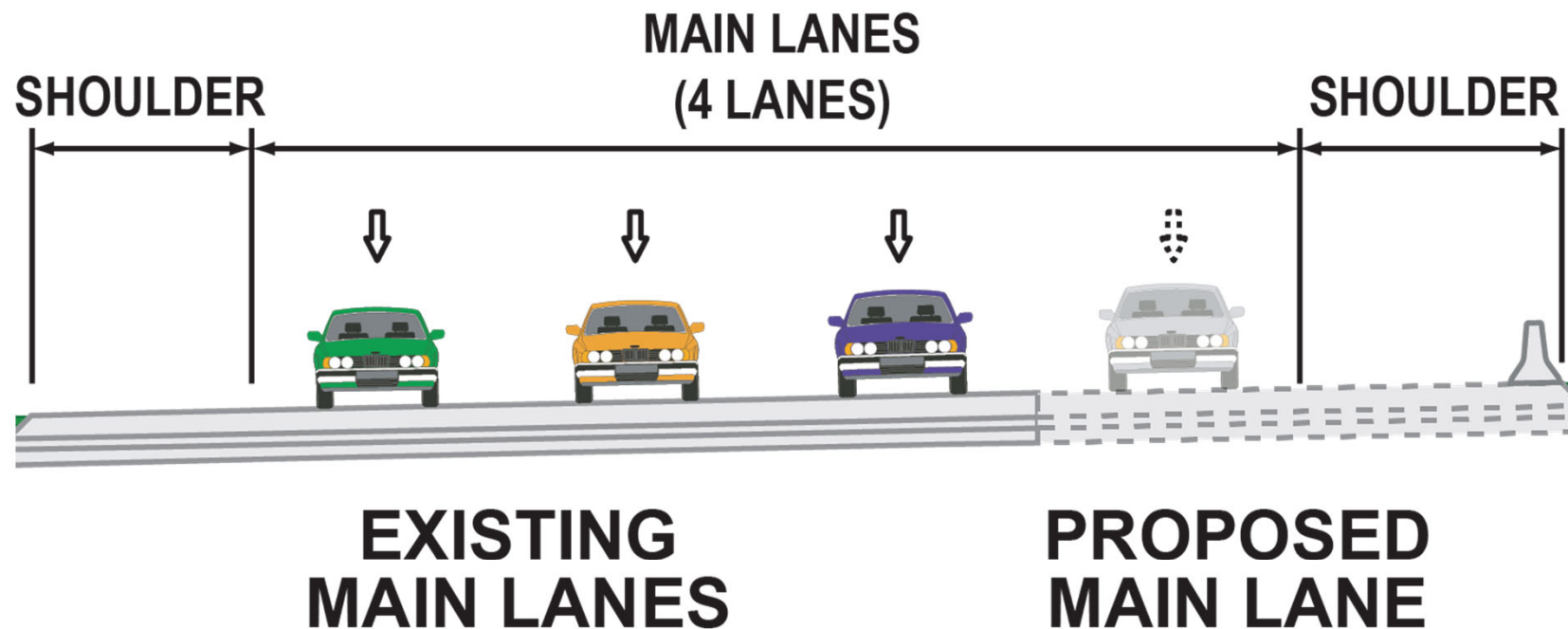

- New lane of travel in each direction

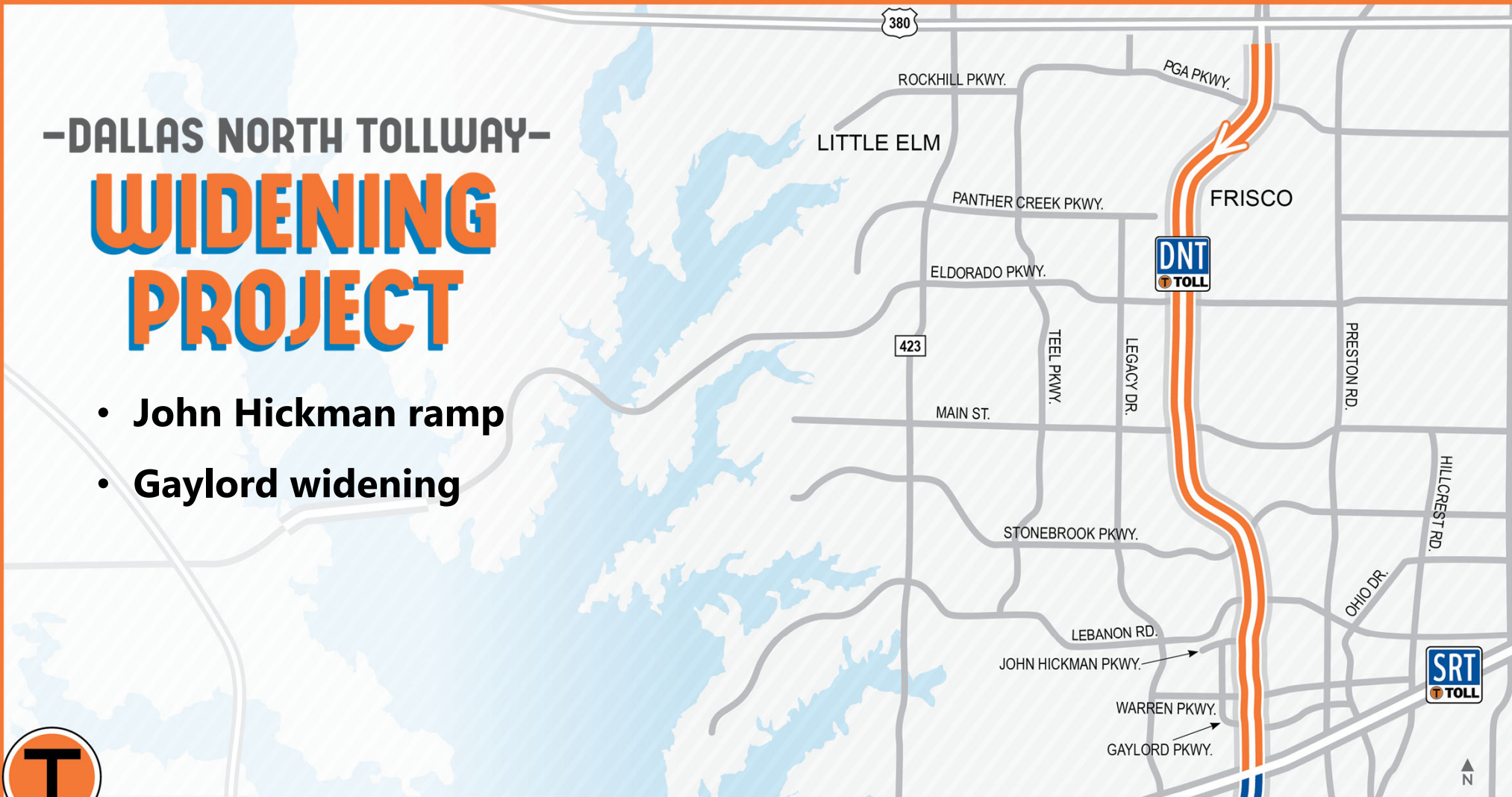


Typical Section on DNT Widening Project

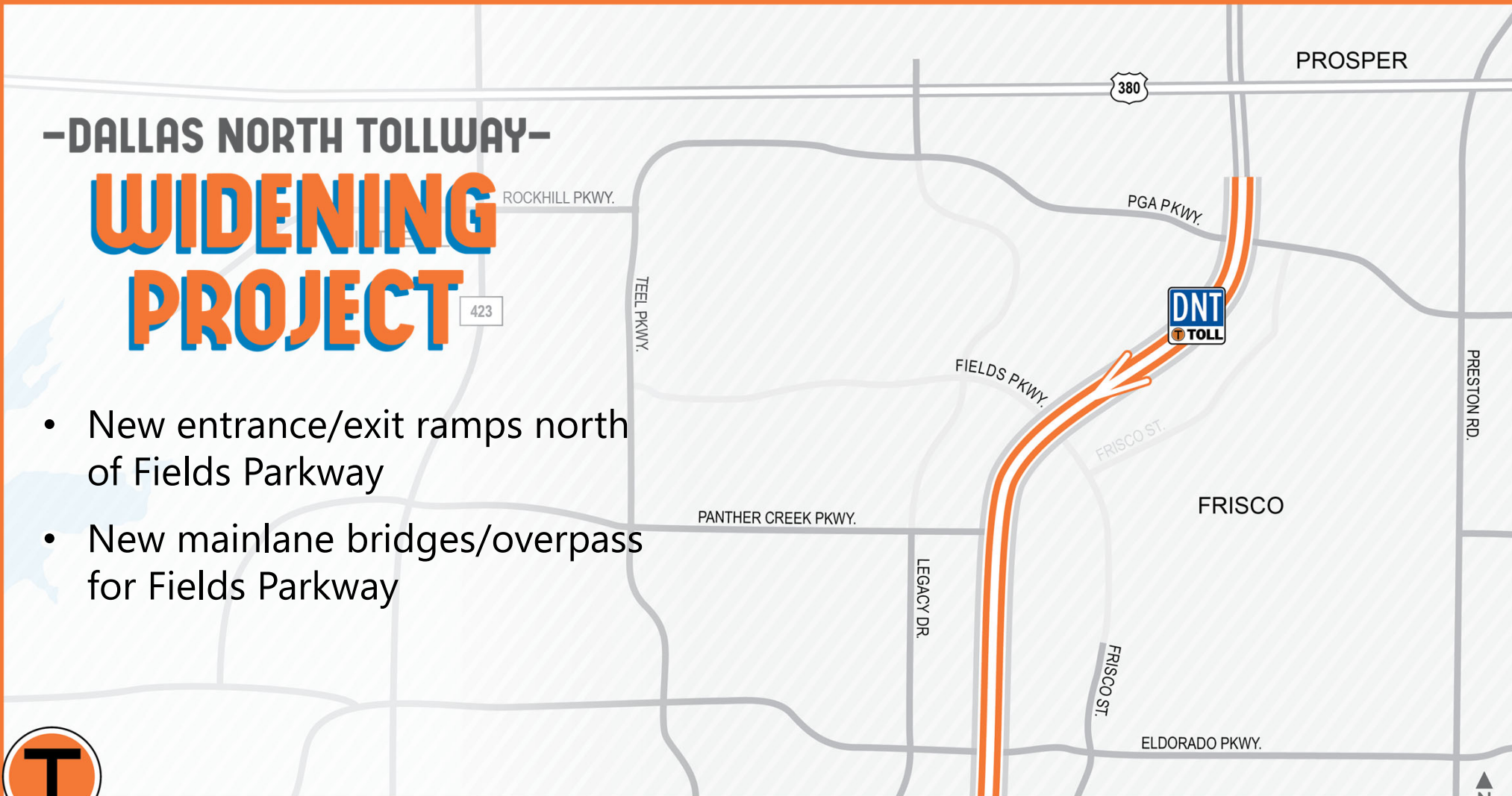

Current Work

- This month, crews began setting construction signs throughout the corridor
- Temporary barriers are now being placed to create work zones



Impacts To Traffic

- Various left lane closures in off-peak hours are currently scheduled throughout the corridor to set temporary concrete barriers



What To Expect (Next 90 Days)

- Signage will be in place
- Temporary concrete barriers will be set along the corridor to create work zones
- Excavation will begin in the median
- Demolition of existing Fields Pkwy. bridge will begin



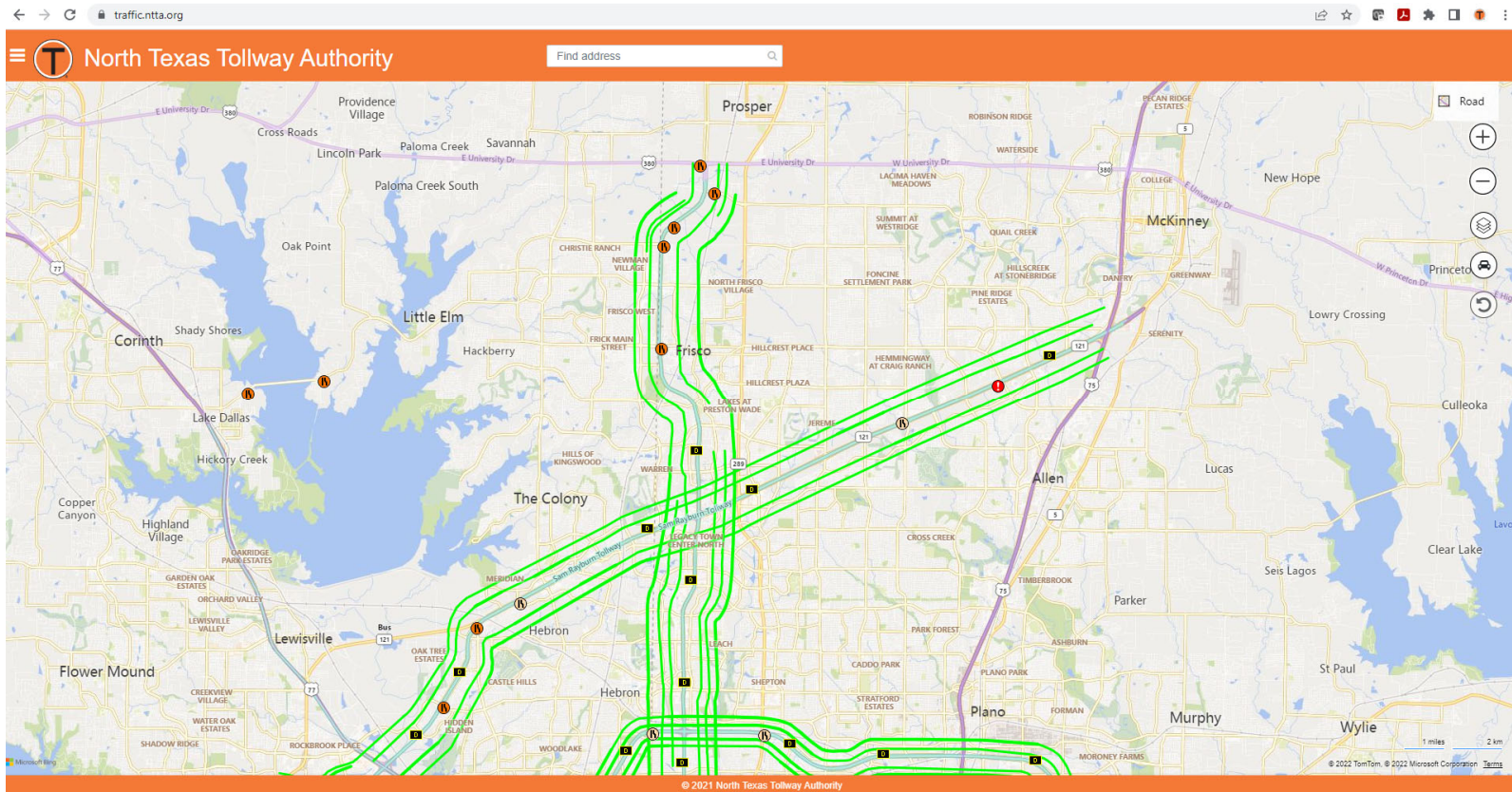

Dallas North Tollway Widening Project

SPRING 2022

The Dallas North Tollway (DNT) is being widened between the Sam Rayburn Tollway (SRT) and US 380 to add capacity.

This project, which will begin in summer 2022, will add an additional lane in each direction and help traffic flow as the population growth continues in northern Collin and Denton counties.

Along with widening the DNT mainlanes, the project team will reconstruct the intersection and DNT bridge over Fields Parkway in Frisco.

Opening date: Late 2025

TRAFFIC ADVISORY

The following closures are needed for construction activities associated with the [SRT Fourth Lane Project](#):



Thursday, Feb 6, through the morning of Friday, Feb. 7 (Overnight)

The following lane and ramp closures will take place from 8 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 6, through 5 a.m. Friday, Feb. 7:

- All lanes of Coit Road, including the U-turns, between east- and westbound SH 121 (the SRT frontage road)
- Two westbound right lanes at Coit Road
- Westbound entrance ramp from Independence Parkway

Northbound Coit Road detour: Motorists will turn right onto SH 121 and make a U-turn at Independence Parkway. Motorists will then continue west to Coit Road where they will turn right.

Southbound Coit Road detour: Motorists will turn right onto SH 121 and make a U-turn at Hillcrest Road. Motorists will then continue east to Coit Road where they will turn right.

Construction work for this project includes adding a fourth lane in each direction from US 75 to south of Denton Tap Road.

Changeable message signs will be placed prior to lane closures in the construction area.

All closures are subject to weather conditions and will be postponed, if necessary. Motorists are urged to use caution in the construction area.

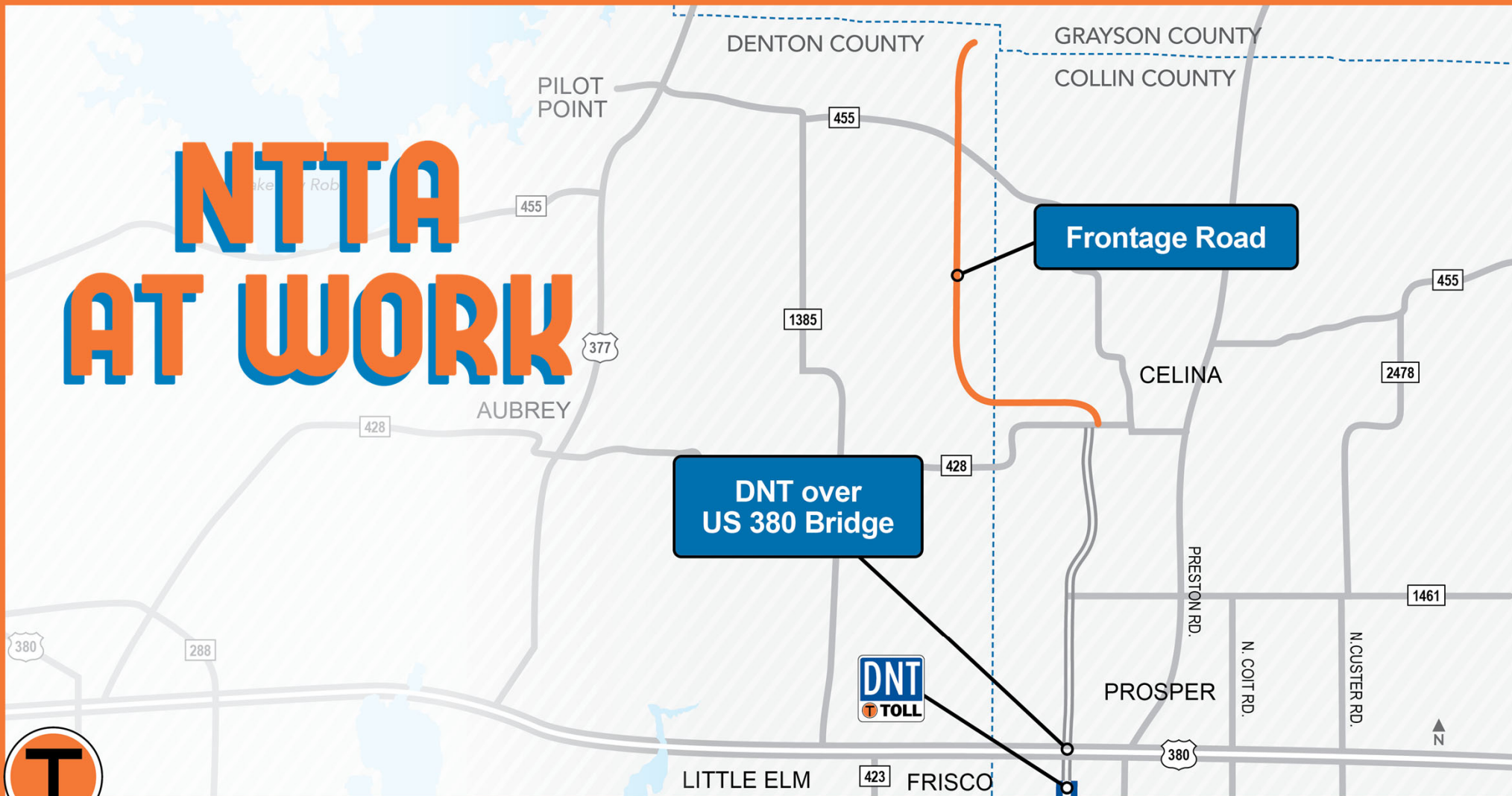


Business Information Group (BIG) Meetings
